## **CORRESPONDENCE**

**Letter** to Town Supervisor from Donna Brown, St. Lawrence County Real Property Tax Agency, regarding 2017 Exemption/Income Ceiling Changes. If we want to change the Senior Citizen Exemption income limit, we need to let them know by February 1<sup>st</sup>. Our limit is \$18,000 at the present time and has not been changed for about 17 years. If we change it, we need to have a public hearing.

**Fund Balance Policy** that was passed by the town board on February 24, 2015 (as part of the Corrective Action Plan recommended by the New York State Comptroller's Office). The plan included a 5-Year projection, updated annually. We are ahead of schedule, since our fund balance at this time is approximately \$259,000.00.

Supervisor Powers stated that she is so happy this year to have Laurie Hance in place to assist with making sure that the books are in line and to answer questions about the budget using her experience.

Councilman Huntley stated that the fact that she works for both the supervisor and the highway department seems to work well.
