NEW BUSINESS

Motion by John Glasgow, seconded by Roger Murray, all in favor, to adopt Resolution #IV-2021: Holding Harmless the County of St. Lawrence for Providing Service for 2021. (see attached).

OLD BUSINESS

Dan Bronson Subdivison Abandonment: Mr. Bronson has decided to abandon his subdivison, so it will not be mapped at Real Property.

Councilman Murray asked what if he wanted to sell a portion of his subdivision? Is there a time limit? Code Enforcement Officer Clay Streit stated that there is a set number that anyone can sell within a set number of years.

Councilman Huntley asked if we should follow up with Buddy Rouleau, but the consensus was that we do not need to.

Planning Board Update:

Planning Board Chairman Pete Pomainville addressed the board. He introduced 2 planning board members, Justin Planty and Peter Whalen. Mr. Pomainville stated that they met to work on solar regulations. They have been looking at some from other towns and will be putting parts of each together to come up with something that works for our town. He said that as chairman of the planning board, he requests that the town board consider a 6-month moratorium on solar and wind renewable energy.

Town Attorney Colin Loomis stated that he recommends doing 2 moratoriums, one on solar and one on wind. We can work on passing the law for solar renewable energy during this 6 months. We can then extend the moratorium for wind another 6 months while we work on the wind renewable energy law.

Motion by Roger Murray, seconded by Dan Huntley, all in favor, to direct Town Attorney Colin Loomis to draft 2 local laws for a 6-month moratorium on solar and wind power. We will set the public hearing and SEQR hearing for March 30, 2021 at 6:45 and 7:00 PM, with the regular meeting being held at 7:15 PM.

Councilman Murray stated that he has attended a couple planning board meetings and he is very impressed with the job that they are doing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the Town of Pierrepont will indemnify and hold harmless the County, their officers, directors, partners, representatives, agents and employees from and against any and all claims, suits, liens, judgments, damages, losses and expenses, including legal fees and all court costs and liability (including statutory liability) arising in whole or in part and in any manner from injury and/or death of person or damage to or loss of any property relating to or arising out of any negligent or intentional acts and/or omissions of the Town of Pierrepont or any of its directors, officers, employees, contractors, representatives, or agents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following request for General Liability (GL) coverage is as follows:

\$3,000,000 General Aggregate

\$1,000,000 Personal Injury

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that St. Lawrence County shall be an additional insured on the GL Policy, via ISO endorsement CG 2026.
