The Town Board of the Town of Pierrepont held their Public Hearing on the 2022 BUDGET on Thursday, November 4, 2021 at the Pierrepont Town Hall, commencing at 6:35 PM.

Supervisor Powers called the hearing to order at 6:35 PM. She stated that the taxes will be raised from \$5.35 per thousand on a \$100,000 home to \$5.39 per thousand on a \$100,000 home. We are staying under the 2% tax cap.

Darrin Richards, our code enforcement officer was present. He also works for the Town of Colton. He stated that it has been discussed about letting the Town of Pierrepont use their transfer station, possibly with the taxes being levied on the Town of Pierrepont. He asked what the board thought about the idea. Councilman McCormick stated that it had been discussed years ago, but would not be feasible for our town because of the cost.

There being no more comments, Supervisor Powers closed the public hearing and called to order a regular meeting at 6:49 PM.
